About Thank a Veteran

Beginning at the end of May, 2018, Victoria County Clerk, Heidi Easley, is proud to announce the “Thank a Vet” discount program. We salute the men and women who have served in our Armed Forces, as well as those who wear the uniform and defend our country today. This program provides a photo ID (FREE OF CHARGE) to Victoria County veterans who have filed their DD form 214 (Certificate of release or discharge from active duty) in our office.

Recording Your DD-214

Discharged or retired military personnel should record their military separation papers or DD-214 in the Victoria County Clerk’s office. By recording your discharge you will be able to obtain certified copies, free of charge, and have the security of knowing that your document is a permanent non-public record. Discharge papers are held in the strictest confidence and can only be accessed by the service member, his or her legal guardian, or individuals with signed and notarized authorization from the service member. Both the recording and certification of your DD-214 are FREE.

If you recorded your DD-214 prior to the launch of the “Thank a Vet” discount program, the County Clerk’s office can verify that your discharge is recorded and can then issue your “Thank a Vet” ID card.
