Primary Objectives

Performs intermediate duties operating the light bridge construction and maintenance trucks and equipment in a variety of maintenance activities including loading, hauling, and related operations; and to perform semi-skilled bridge maintenance tasks. This position is also responsible for greeting customers, accessing a reasonable price for waste, securely collecting payment, and documenting transactions. The work area is to be kept neat and organized which includes grass mowing and sweeping. Waste in the designated truck or container is to be taken to the landfill.

Work is performed under the limited supervision of the Foreman.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Operate light construction and maintenance equipment such as backhoes, dump trucks, loaders, concrete mixers, and various other light equipment for a variety of bridge maintenance and construction operations.
- 2. Perform additional bridge construction and maintenance tasks such as driving trucks, repairing potholes, shoulder and edgework paving, building and setting forms, hanging steel, pouring and finishing concrete and a variety of minor maintenance activities for the county Road and Bridge Department.
- 3. Install driveway and cross culverts; build head walls and forms.
- 4. Pick-up and deliver equipment and concrete materials to and from construction sites.
- 5. Install street barricades and cones prior to the performance of street repair activities; direct and control traffic around work sites.
- 6. Perform preventive maintenance on equipment as required.
- 7. Inspect equipment for proper functioning and safety.
- 8. Assist with work of other staff.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- ➤ High School Diploma/GED and considerable (3-5 years) experience required.
- ➤ Valid Texas Driver's License.

WORKING CONDITIONS

The characteristics listed below are representative of the physical demands, physical agility, sensory requirements, and environmental exposures required by an individual to successfully perform the essential duties of this position.
